

Visitor Safety

Fire Safety

If you discover or suspect a fire you should activate the nearest Fire Alarm Call Point. Only attempt to tackle a fire with equipment provided if there is no risk to yourself.

If you hear an alarm you should leave the area as quick and calmly as possible, following the nearest marked fire escape route signs.

Do not attempt to use the lifts and do not waste time collecting belongings.

You should make your way to the following Assembly Point:- Seymour Dugan, Ridgeway Street Junction.

Site Safety
